# *“Home Alone”-Inspired Filthy Animal Pizza*



## INGREDIENTS

- 1 tablespoon olive oil
- 1 large yellow onion, thinly sliced
- 2 links spicy Italian sausage, thinly sliced
- 4 slices hardwood smoked bacon
- 1 ball of pizza dough, store-bought or homemade
- Nonstick cooking spray and/or cornmeal (optional)
- 3/4 cup pizza sauce
- 6 ounces prepared pulled pork
- 4 ounces shredded pepper jack cheese
- 1/4 cup chopped fresh parsley

## INSTRUCTIONS

Heat oil in large skillet over medium heat. Add onion and cook 20 to 25 minutes or until onion is deeply caramelized, stirring occasionally. Transfer onion to small bowl; return skillet to heat. Add sausage to skillet; cook 6 to 8 minutes or until cooked through, stirring occasionally.

Meanwhile, preheat oven to 375 degrees F. On rimmed baking pan lined with parchment paper, arrange bacon slices in single layer. Bake 18 to 20 minutes or until crisp. Transfer bacon to paper-towel lined plate. Let cool; then crumble bacon.

Increase oven temperature to 450 degrees F. Press pizza dough into large circle on pizza stone or pan (spray with cooking spray or sprinkle with cornmeal first if you're worried about dough sticking). Bake 10 minutes or until light golden brown and almost cooked through.

Remove crust from oven. Spread with pizza sauce, then top with pulled pork, cheese, caramelized onion, sausage and bacon. Bake 5 to 7 minutes longer, or until crust is cooked through and toppings are hot. Remove from oven; sprinkle with parsley and serve immediately.
