Art Guidelines

- Each teen participant (grade 6-12) may enter up to three original works on paper, no larger than 16" x 20", in any medium, e.g. sketching (pencil, watercolor, charcoal), painting (acrylic, oil, pastel, etc.), sculpture (based on size and shape these may only be shown at the reception), photography, as well as original works of writing such as poetry and short stories.
- Submissions will be returned after exhibition.
- A registration form must be submitted along with each piece of artwork.

Writing Guidelines

- Each teen participant (grade 6 12) may enter one short story, poem or non-fiction essay.
- Entries must be the original work of the submitter.
- Entries must be typed, on one-sided 8 ½" x 11" paper. <u>Hand written entries will not be considered</u>. Instead of submitting a hard copy, teens can also e-mail a copy of their work as an attachment to: <u>andrew.mihopulos@sachemlibrary.org</u> with the subject heading "Teen Art Show."
- Pages must be numbered.
- Maximum Pages:

Poetry -2 pgs.

Prose (i.e. short story, non-fiction essay) -4 pgs.

You may hand deliver artwork and writing submissions to the Teen Services desk at Sachem Public Library– 150 Holbrook Road, Holbrook, NY 11741

- All submissions are due between March 4 March 22, 2024 and should be delivered during the following times:
 - 9:30am-8:30pm Monday-Friday; 9:30am-4:30pm Saturday; or 12:00-3:30pm Sunday.
- Artwork will be displayed from Monday, April 1 Tuesday, April 30, 2024.
- Work for the art exhibit may not be removed before **May 1, 2024** unless prior arrangements are made. Please bring photo identification or library card with you when picking up your artwork.
- If submitted by a teacher, all work will be returned to the teacher.
- If submitted by a teen, the artist is responsible for picking up their work in Teen Services after art exhibit is finished (no later than May 19, 2024).

All works must be original interpretations by the artist. No copies will be accepted.

All work is subject to review by the Sachem Public Library. The library reserves the right to refuse any entry.
