 - You must adhere to the hours you signed up for.
 - You can not show up the day of the event and get community service hours unless you have been notified ahead of time that you have been selected to be a volunteer.
 - You must check in and out with a librarian when you are arriving/leaving.
- You are expected to conduct yourself in a professional manner.
